

Uniform requirements of 295 Air Training Corps, subject to change so please check with staff.

All Cadets will be issued with the following items:













Cadets will also be issued when required:

- White gloves
- White belt
- Coveralls/flying suit

Cadets will need to supply:

- DMS (directly moulded sole) parade shoes (search DMS parade)
- Black socks
- 15 denier Barely Black tights or stockings. (To be worn with skirt only)
- RAF stable belt for some events (notice will be given).



DMS male parade shoes can be worn by all cadets' genders.

Cadets will need to have a general cleaning kit to clean footwear and items of clothing, the basics are.

- Black and Brown (if req) shoe polish.
- Cotton wall (or similar) for bulling (adding a high shine)
- Toothbrush (old or cheap)
- Ironing cloth, or similar.
- Starch (optional)
- Lint remover (several options, or Sellotape)
- Small sewing kit.


The uniform is issued to the cadets, they will also be responsible for caring, cleaning and ironing their uniform.

## Uniform details 295 RAFAC

We would suggest cadets to purchase their own MTP (Multi terrain pattern (camouflage uniform brown in nature)), this can be easily found on eBay or similar sites or by searching the internet. The items needed will be:



- MTP trousers
- MTP shirt (Barrack shirts are OK for parade nights but not for some field events, if in doubt please speak with staff)
- Olive green, black or brown t-shirt
- MTP Smock
- Black or dark brown boots (above ankle in height please)
- Trouser ties (to correctly blouse trousers)

Other items can be purchased but will probably not be required that often:

- MTP waterproofs
- MTP bonnie and or beanie hat
- Brown or black gloves (MTP if available)
- Buffalo smock (undergarment to keep warm, please check with staff)



Cadets will not be allowed to wear UBACS (shirt with plain brown centre and camouflage arm, collar) so please do not purchase.

## Uniform details 295 RAFAC

Cadets will also need other items for some events. We would recommend a good pair of walking boots, above ankle is best for this event and they will be used for walking days and Duke of Edinburgh expeditions. They will also need a good pair of walking trousers (not jeans), tops and lightweight waterproof jacket. As they progress, they will need a sleeping bag with a minimum of 3 season rating, backpack, day packs, mess tins. Kits list should be supplied with plenty of notice.

If you are unable to purchase any item, please feel free to speak to a member of staff, for some events we may be able to supply some items.

We also have a small stock of CS95 (Combat Soldier 1995 (old camouflage uniform green in nature)) but please do not purchase this yourself. Cadets will be required to supply black boots for wearing with this uniform.
